Headmaster's Scholarship Information Sheet 2017

Academic scholarship

Candidates are required take the following papers:

- Non-Verbal Reasoning
- Verbal Reasoning
- Mathematics

Music scholarship

Candidates are expected to have achieved a graded standard in their first instrument (preferably Grade 2 for entry to Form III and Grade 3 for entry to Forms V & VI).

Candidates will be required to sit papers in Non-Verbal and Verbal Reasoning, and attend an audition stating which piece(s) of music they will be performing.

All-Rounder Award

Candidates are expected to achieve a good performance in sport or creative arts. Candidates are required to sit papers in Non-Verbal and Verbal Reasoning, submit a small portfolio of information of their achievements and attend a short interview with the Headmaster.

General

Scholarships will be reviewed each year and could be applicable throughout the holder's time provided the pupil continues to meet the expectations of a scholar.

Headmaster's Scholarships will be announced at the end of the Autumn Term. Candidates who are offered an award will be required to accept or decline it within an agreed period of time or it will be forfeited and may be offered to another pupil.

Acceptance of an award is regarded as a firm commitment that the candidate will take up a place in Form III (or an older year if appropriate) at St George's and he or she will be expected to withdraw from any alternative applications.
